We would like to remind students and parents about the Acceptable Dress and the Cell Phones/Electronic Devices – please see below:

### Acceptable Dress

*O'Maley Middle School students take responsibility for the process of learning. They are expected to dress appropriately for a learning environment.*

*Students are expected to dress appropriately during school hours, on school property, on field trips, and all school events. Revealing clothes or clothes with inappropriate pictures or words, or clothing that is unsafe or inappropriate for school will not be allowed. For example, dress that is more appropriate for the beach should be worn at the beach and not in school (e.g. bellies and chests should not be exposed, spaghetti-strapped tank tops not allowed, short length shorts not allowed and no undergarments showing)*

*Should attire be considered unacceptable, we will phone home and request a change of clothes to be brought to school. Students are not allowed to wear hats, caps or bandannas in school.*

### Cell Phones/Electronic Devices

*The use of cell phones and all other electronic communication devices is prohibited in school. In the event that it can be demonstrated that the use of a device is a necessity during class hours, the principal may waive this policy to accommodate the needs of a particular student or staff.*
